WHAT IS WOMEN'S STUDIES AND GENDER RELATIONS (WSGR)?

- An interdisciplinary field of study that has moved from being “by, for and about women” to exploring how different identities (gendered, racialized, classed, etc.) and forms of oppression (sexism, racism, classism, capitalism, etc.) overlap and intersect.
- Connects learning and research to community action and meaningful social change!
- There is a common misperception that feminism is anti-male. It isn't. Feminism is against sexism, racism, homophobia, capitalist patriarchy and other systemic forms of oppression. That is something both women and men can get behind!
- Leads to career paths in education, health care, media, law, public relations, international work, political science, conflict resolution, art, medicine, and science.
- Anyone can do the WSGR certificate! Students of any gender, in pre-university, technology and professional programs are all eligible.
- No extra course work is involved! Students complete six courses in the WSGR field of study as part of their overall requirements.
